Leviticus 26

- **15** And if ye shall despise my statutes, or if your soul abhor my judgments, so that ye will not do all my commandments, but that ye break my covenant:
- 16 I also will do this unto you; I will even appoint over you terror, consumption, and the burning ague, that shall consume the eyes, and cause sorrow of heart: and ye shall sow your seed in vain,

for your enemies shall eat it.

27 And if ye will not for all this hearken unto me, but walk contrary unto me;

28 Then I will walk contrary unto you also in fury; and I, even I, will chastise you seven times for your sins.

29 And ye shall eat the flesh of your sons, and the flesh of your daughters shall ye eat.

31 And I will make your cities waste, and bring your sanctuaries unto desolation, and I will not smell the savour of your sweet odours.

After King Solomon's death while the kingdom was split into two, the 10 tribes gets removed from Israel by the Assyrians in 722 BC:

2 Kings 17

- **9** And the children of Israel did secretly those things that were not right against the Lord their God, and they built them high places in all their cities, from the tower of the watchmen to the fenced city.
- 10 And they set them up images and groves in every high hill, and under every green tree:
- 11 And there they burnt incense in all the high places, as did the heathen whom the Lord carried away before them; and wrought wicked things to provoke the Lord to anger:
- 12 For they served idols, whereof the Lord had said unto them, Ye shall not do this thing.
- 13 Yet the Lord testified against Israel, and against Judah, by all the prophets, and by all the seers, saying, Turn ye from your evil ways, and keep my commandments and my statutes, according to all the law which I commanded your fathers, and

which I sent to you by my servants the prophets.

18 Therefore the Lord was very angry with Israel, and removed them out of his sight: there was none left but the tribe of Judah only.

19 Also Judah kept not the commandments of the Lord their God, but walked in the statutes of Israel which they made.

20 And the Lord rejected all the seed of Israel, and afflicted them, and delivered them into the hand of spoilers, until he had cast them out of his sight.

21 For he rent Israel from the house of David; and they made Jeroboam the son of Nebat king: and Jeroboam drave Israel from following the Lord, and made them sin a great sin.

d23 Until the Lord removed Israel out of his sight, as he had said by all his servants the prophets. So was Israel carried away out of their own land to Assyria unto this day.

The Lord's warning Judah thur Jer. Using the 10 tribes as an example. Judah's wickedness is going to get them kicked out:

Jeremiah 7

Last king of Judah Zedekiah Judah gets taken captive by King Nebu. in 586

God of Israel.

14 Moreover all the chief of the priests, and the people, transgressed very much after all the abominations of the heathen; and polluted the house of the Lord which he had hallowed in Jerusalem.

servants to him and his sons until the reign of the kingdom of Persia:

Daniel while captive in Babylon confirms the curses written by Moses to take place on the Israelites for disobedience. Judah was to be captive for 70 years and then return into the land and they would be in the land until the Messiah was to get cut off.

Daniel 9

- **9** In the first year of Darius the son of Ahasuerus, of the seed of the Medes, which was made king over the realm of the Chaldeans;
- 2 In the first year of his reign I Daniel understood by books the number of the years, whereof the word of the Lord came to Jeremiah the prophet, that he would accomplish seventy years in the desolations of Jerusalem.
- **3** And I set my face unto the Lord God, to seek by prayer and supplications, with fasting, and sackcloth, and ashes:
- 4 And I prayed unto the Lord my God, and made my confession, and said, O Lord, the great and dreadful God, keeping the covenant and mercy to them that love him, and to them that keep his

commandments;

5 We have sinned, and have committed iniquity, and have done wickedly, and have rebelled, even by departing from thy precepts and from thy judgments:

11 Yea, all Israel have transgressed thy law, even by departing, that they might not obey thy voice; therefore the curse is poured upon us, and the oath that is written in the law of Moses the servant of God, because we have sinned against him.

12 And he hath confirmed his words, which he spake against us, and against our judges that judged us, by bringing upon us a great evil: for under the whole heaven hath not been done as hath been done upon Jerusalem.

24 Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy.

25 Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince shall be seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks: the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times.

26 And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy

the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof shall be with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined.

The Lord prophecies over Israel's captivity

XXVII THE HISTORY OF THE IDUMÆANS

SHORTLY after Jerusalem's fall and Judah's exile to Babylon in 586 B.C., the Edomites migrated, for some reason, from their particular home in Mt. Seir, to southern Judah and the adjacent portions of the Negeb, and from that time onward they were known as Idumæans. An analogy, it will be remembered, took place in the history of Israel; for, prior to Israel's captivity by Nebuchadnezzar, their history is usually spoken of as "the history of the Hebrews," whereas, after their captivity, we are accustomed to speak of their history as "the history of the Jews."

It was the Greeks who gave the Edomites their new name, and spoke of their new home in southern Judah as "Idumæa." The latter occurs once in the *New Testament* (Mk. 3:8).

Their migration was apparently due to the northern movement of the desert Arabs known as the Nabateans, who suddenly emerged out of the wilds of Central Arabia. For a long time they threatened Edomite territory, pushing steadily nearer and nearer in the direction of Mt. Seir, until at some time during the sixth century B.C. they succeeded in expelling the sons of Esau from their mountain fastnesses, and took possession of the rock-city of Petra. The history of the Nabateans forms a chapter by itself; but, here, it must be observed that the migration of the Edomites from Mt. Seir to southern Judah cannot be

dissociated from the invasion of the Nabateans who drove them from their old

Idumea accused by God for stealing his peoples land:

Ezekiel 36

- **36** Also, thou son of man, prophesy unto the mountains of Israel, and say, Ye mountains of Israel, hear the word of the Lord:
- 2 Thus saith the Lord God; Because the enemy (Edom) hath said against you, Aha, even the ancient high places are ours in possession:
- 3 Therefore prophesy and say, Thus saith the Lord God; Because they have made you desolate, and swallowed you up on every side, that ye might be a possession unto the residue of the heathen, and ye are taken up in the lips of talkers, and are an infamy (shame) of the people:
- 4 Therefore, ye mountains of Israel, hear the word of the Lord God; Thus saith the Lord God to the mountains, and to the hills, to the rivers, and to the valleys, to the desolate wastes, and to the cities that are forsaken, which became a prey and derision to the residue of the heathen that are

round about;

5 Therefore thus saith the Lord God; Surely in the fire of my jealousy have I spoken against the residue of the heathen, and against all IDUMEA, which have appointed MY LAND into THEIR possession with the joy of all their heart, with despiteful minds, to cast it out for a prey.

The Lord is against Edom (Mt. Sier) because of their hatred and violence against Israel. They have also taken the Lords land into their possession:

Ezekiel 35

13 Thus with your mouth ye have boasted against me, and have multiplied your words against me: I have heard them.
