

## **HARLOTS & COMMON CRIMINALS... ENTERING THE KINGDOM BEFORE FAKE CHRISTIANS**

Unfortunately, the majority of the world and so called Christians are going down the wrong path and do not worship God according to what is written in the Bible because Satan has deceived the whole world. However, God is going to give us a chance to hear his true uncut Word so that we can serve him correctly in order to receive salvation but the problem is when we preach truth, the masses reject it because they believe in lies and thus do not want to follow the truth (drunk with false doctrine) and evidently have too much pride to receive correction. On the other hand, non indoctrinated people, the worldly, despised, and humble people may start off in disbelief but when they hear the word of truth they are wise and humble enough to repent and follow it.

This parable describes two types of people. People that profess to be Christians, yet contradict His Word and people that do not know and care too much about His Word but after hearing it, repent and follow Him.

The second son represents all the people that have been going to church their whole life, yet have been wrong and deceived their whole life due to deception. They say that they are going to do God's will and think they are doing God's will but they actually are not because they do not follow God's laws, in fact they think that we don't have to keep them which is why they have

established their own righteousness like Sunday worship, Christmas, Easter, and charismatic experiences.

Some dope dealers, gang bangers and prostitutes will get into the kingdom before many of the people following the established religion of false Christianity because the false Christians want to hold on to and protect their false worship/traditions and thus reject the law/will of God which prevents them from getting into the kingdom. Some of these same false Christians have the audacity to look down on the common sinners, not realizing that these same sinners will make it into the kingdom before them because they do not practice false Christianity and have nothing to protect and therefore they accept the word and repent and start to keep the law.

Furthermore, when those that preach and keep God's laws and customs, tell the false Christians who think they are right, to serve God according to what is written in the Bible, they refuse to do so and thus do not believe in the Bible but the common sinners end up believing and doing God's will.

John the Baptist was stand offish and was not a traditional preacher but he taught the truth , just like us. The holier than thou religious folks of John's day rejected John just as they reject what we preach.

Note: Many of these false Christians look down at our pastors, either for how they speak or for not going to seminary school but they said they same thing about Jesus, John, and the apostles in Acts 4 - they called them ignorant and marveled at how they

were able to do miracles which is why the Lord said do not judge according to appearance.

Matthew 21:28-32

King James Version (KJV)

<sup>28</sup> But what think ye? A certain man had two sons; and he came to the first, and said, Son, go work to day in my vineyard.

<sup>29</sup> He answered and said, I will not: but afterward he repented, and went.

<sup>30</sup> And he came to the second, and said likewise. And he answered and said, I go, sir: and went not.

<sup>31</sup> Whether of them twain did the will of his father? They say unto him, The first. Jesus saith unto them, Verily I say unto you, That the publicans and the harlots go into the kingdom of God before you.

<sup>32</sup> For John came unto you in the way of righteousness, and ye believed him not: but the publicans and the harlots believed him: and ye, when ye had seen it, repented not afterward, that ye might believe him.

The so called wise people and "saved" Christians already think they are right, thus they will not repent and will not hear/accept the truth no matter who it comes from! This is why so called Christians rejected and killed the prophets even Jesus, for preaching and keeping the law. The majority do not realize that the true prophets, servants, and disciples of God were rejected by the mainstream religious establishment. This is why we are not surprised that we are rejected because we preach in

the same vein as them.

In v. 16-17 the Lord is showing us that No matter how we bring the truth to the so called wise and holy Christians they find an excuse to reject it. John and Jesus both brought the truth in different ways as John was not normal, stayed to himself, and was odd and Jesus was a cool, people's person that hung out with the common folks. They both preached the truth yet were rejected by the so called Christian leaders and the masses.

They said John had a devil, that Jesus was a glutton, and they say that we are in a cult all for preaching the truth. But wisdom is justified by her children - when we preach the law and get people that was in the world to stop sinning and begin to love God and their neighbor in truth, and understand the mysteries of God is that a bad thing? According to the false Christians it must be because they reject us and God's word. Thus they don't even understand what they are saying.

Such people have never repented because they think they know it all.

Furthermore, in v. 25 Jesus informs us that the wisdom of God is hidden from the so called prudent religious leaders and their followers (eg. The Roman Catholic Church and all mainstream denominations) and the word is not hidden literally but they will not see it for what it is because they think they know it all and thus reject it due to their pride. The false prophets have fooled themselves into thinking that they have everything right because they are reprobate and Satan is blessing them with the money that they are swindling from the masses who are deceived and caught up on prosperity, prestige, lustful traditions and easy

limitless worship. On the other hand, the truth is given to what the world considers base (Israel aka African Americans, mostly uneducated by the worlds standards). John 7 , FOT, Jews were astounded at how Jesus knew the scriptures so well without going to any of their organized seminary schools. Babes = 1 cor 1 God uses the base things of the world to confound the so called wise..

Matthew 11:11

King James Version (KJV)

<sup>11</sup> Verily I say unto you, Among them that are born of women there hath not risen a greater than John the Baptist: notwithstanding he that is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he.

<sup>16</sup> But whereunto shall I liken this generation? It is like unto children sitting in the markets, and calling unto their fellows,

<sup>17</sup> And saying, We have piped unto you, and ye have not danced; we have mourned unto you, and ye have not lamented.

<sup>18</sup> For John came neither eating nor drinking, and they say, He hath a devil.

<sup>19</sup> The Son of man came eating and drinking, and they say, Behold a man gluttonous, and a winebibber, a friend of publicans and sinners. But wisdom is justified of her children.

<sup>20</sup> Then began he to upbraid the cities wherein most of his mighty works were done, because they repented not:

<sup>25</sup> At that time Jesus answered and said, I thank thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes.

Levi = Matthew. Jesus and the Father have hid the word from the prudent, thus when Jesus got ready to get his followers, he went to the "babes/base" (the people that the religious establishment looks down upon). People like Matthew/Levi. Matthew followed the Lord immediately and threw a party with the common people. The religious leaders had a problem with the fact that Matthew (like Jesus) hung out with Publicans and sinners but the only way to convert them is to hang out with them. This example shows how and why the publicans are going to get into the kingdom before the froward religious folks.

Verse 36-39 shows the major problem with the religious establishment and mainstream, indoctrinated Christians and that is they are so used to their old false teachings that they cannot accept the truth. This is why Jesus started his church with untainted, untraditional, common people. In order to accept this truth and change your heart you have to forsake everything you were taught in mainstream religion as well your own fleshly ways and thoughts and practices.

Luke 5:27-32

King James Version (KJV)

<sup>27</sup> And after these things he went forth, and saw a publican, named Levi, sitting at the receipt of custom: and he said unto him, Follow me.

<sup>28</sup> And he left all, rose up, and followed him.

<sup>29</sup> And Levi made him a great feast in his own house: and there was a great company of publicans and of others that sat down with them.

<sup>30</sup> But their scribes and Pharisees murmured against his disciples, saying, Why do ye eat and drink with publicans and sinners?

<sup>31</sup> And Jesus answering said unto them, They that are whole need not a physician; but they that are sick.

<sup>32</sup> I came not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.

<sup>36</sup> And he spake also a parable unto them; No man putteth a piece of a new garment upon an old; if otherwise, then both the new maketh a rent, and the piece that was taken out of the new agreeth not with the old.

<sup>37</sup> And no man putteth new wine into old bottles; else the new wine will burst the bottles, and be spilled, and the bottles shall perish.

<sup>38</sup> But new wine must be put into new bottles; and both are preserved.

<sup>39</sup> No man also having drunk old wine straightway desireth new: for he saith, The old is better.

The other reason that the so called religious leaders and average Christians cannot accept the sound doctrine of the Bible is because they have idols in their heart that prevent them from hearing and seeing the truth because they want to do their own will and not God's. When they look as if they want to know and do God's will, it is not with a pure mind. For example, we tell people Christmas is false worship but many people have idols in their mind that won't allow them to give it up, it is "before their face" and thus it is all they believe.

Verse 1 and 4 show that The people knew that Israel was a prophet so they went to him concerning the Word of God but really did not want to hear the word of God.

**This is a form of idolatry and it can't even happen with people in the truth. For example, we in the truth sometimes are faced with temptation and we know what we want to do is wrong but we have an idol in our head and want to do it anyway so we call other people in the truth and ask them what they think - seeking counsel and some people, after they receive the counsel which tells them to not do the thing they wanted to do, they get upset with the person they asked. If so, they have an idol.**

**Well the mainstream churches live in this mindset and are just playing church and the Lord says he is going to destroy the children of Israel for doing this. This is why they have more churches than anybody yet suffer more than anybody.**

**God requires us to repent and remove our idols in order to serve him.**

**Ezekiel 14:1-6**

**King James Version (KJV)**

**14 Then came certain of the elders of Israel unto me, and sat before me.**

**<sup>2</sup> And the word of the Lord came unto me, saying,**

**<sup>3</sup> Son of man, these men have set up their idols in their heart, and put the stumblingblock of their iniquity before their face: should I be enquired of at all by them?**

**<sup>4</sup> Therefore speak unto them, and say unto them, Thus saith the Lord God; Every man of the house of Israel that setteth up his idols in his heart, and putteth the stumblingblock of his iniquity before his face, and cometh to the prophet; I the Lord will answer him that cometh according to the multitude of his idols;**

**<sup>5</sup> That I may take the house of Israel in their own heart, because they are all estranged from me through their idols.**



<sup>6</sup>Therefore say unto the house of Israel, Thus saith the Lord God; Repent, and turn yourselves from your idols; and turn away your faces from all your abominations.

Out of all the people in Jericho the Lord saved a harlot which shows you the type of people who are apt to hear and accept the word of God. She was smart because she heard about the true and living God, believed on his works and decided to help the men of God and have them help her. In today's context, it is the worldly people who have enough common sense and who are not caught up on false notions of security and success that will be receptive to the Word when they hear it. They will realize that the mainstream doctrine which they have heard, is nothing but false doctrine. Then there are those who believe in those lies, that may look down on the people of the world and believe in lies, which is why Jesus said, the harlots and publicans will enter into the kingdom before false Christians.

Joshua 2:1-5

King James Version (KJV)

2 And Joshua the son of Nun sent out of Shittim two men to spy secretly, saying, Go view the land, even Jericho. And they went, and came into an harlot's house, named Rahab, and lodged there.

<sup>2</sup> And it was told the king of Jericho, saying, Behold, there came men in hither to night of the children of Israel to search out the country.

<sup>3</sup> And the king of Jericho sent unto Rahab, saying, Bring forth the men that are come to thee, which are entered into thine house: for they be come to search out all the country.

<sup>4</sup> And the woman took the two men, and hid them, and said thus, There came men unto me, but I wist not whence they were:

<sup>5</sup> And it came to pass about the time of shutting of the gate, when it was dark, that the men went out: whither the men went I wot not: pursue after them quickly; for ye shall overtake them.

<sup>9</sup> And she said unto the men, I know that the Lord hath given you the land, and that your terror is fallen upon us, and that all the inhabitants of the land faint because of you.

<sup>10</sup> For we have heard how the Lord dried up the water of the Red sea for you, when ye came out of Egypt; and what ye did unto the two kings of the Amorites, that were on the other side Jordan, Sihon and Og, whom ye utterly destroyed.

<sup>11</sup> And as soon as we had heard these things, our hearts did melt, neither did there remain any more courage in any man, because of you: for the Lord your God, he is God in heaven above, and in earth beneath.

<sup>12</sup> Now therefore, I pray you, swear unto me by the Lord, since I have shewed you kindness, that ye will also shew kindness unto my father's house, and give me a true token:

**Rahab, the harlot was justified by her works because faith without works is dead. She was the only one saved in Jericho due to her faith and repentance.**

**James 2:25-26**

**King James Version (KJV)**

<sup>25</sup> Likewise also was not Rahab the harlot justified by works, when she had received the messengers, and had sent them out another way?

<sup>26</sup> For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.

The Pharisee's and BIG TIME religious leaders folks got Jesus killed because they were wicked! But the common criminal will be in God's kingdom for his mercy and repentance! Common criminals and sinners cannot remain wicked, sly, and sinful or else they will not be regarded. We have to humbly and earnestly make a change and follow God with all our heart to receive his mercy and forgiveness.

Luke 23:10

King James Version (KJV)

<sup>10</sup> And the **CHIEF PRIESTS** and scribes stood and **vehemently** accused him.

<sup>13</sup> And Pilate, when he had called together the chief priests and the rulers and the people,

<sup>14</sup> Said unto them, **Ye have brought this man unto me, as one that PERVERTETH the people:** and, behold, I, having examined him before you, have found no fault in this man touching those things whereof ye accuse him:

<sup>21</sup> But they cried, saying, Crucify him, crucify him.

<sup>38</sup> And a superscription also was written over him in letters of

Greek, and Latin, and Hebrew, This Is The King Of The Jews.

<sup>39</sup> And one of the malefactors which were hanged railed on him, saying, If thou be Christ, save thyself and us.

<sup>40</sup> But the other answering rebuked him, saying, Dost not thou fear God, seeing thou art in the same condemnation?

<sup>41</sup> And we indeed justly; for we receive the due reward of our deeds: but this man hath done nothing amiss.

<sup>42</sup> And he said unto Jesus, Lord, remember me when thou comest into thy kingdom.

<sup>43</sup> And Jesus said unto him, Verily I say unto thee, Today shalt thou be with me in paradise.

**Mary Had Seven Devils but was delivered from them and became a disciple of Christ!**

**Luke 8:1-3**

**King James Version (KJV)**

**8** And it came to pass afterward, that he went throughout every city and village, preaching and shewing the glad tidings of the kingdom of God: and the twelve were with him,

**2** And certain women, which had been healed of evil spirits and infirmities, Mary called Magdalene, out of whom went seven devils,

**3** And Joanna the wife of Chuza Herod's steward, and Susanna, and many others, which ministered unto him of their substance.

## Luke 7:29-50

<sup>29</sup> And all the people that heard him, and the publicans, justified God, being baptized with the baptism of John.

<sup>30</sup> But the Pharisees and lawyers rejected the counsel of God against themselves, being not baptized of him.

<sup>31</sup> And the Lord said, Whereunto then shall I liken the men of this generation? and to what are they like?

<sup>32</sup> They are like unto children sitting in the marketplace, and calling one to another, and saying, We have piped unto you, and ye have not danced; we have mourned to you, and ye have not wept.

<sup>33</sup> For John the Baptist came neither eating bread nor drinking wine; and ye say, He hath a devil.

<sup>34</sup> The Son of man is come eating and drinking; and ye say, Behold a gluttonous man, and a winebibber, a friend of publicans and sinners!

<sup>35</sup> But wisdom is justified of all her children.

<sup>36</sup> And one of the Pharisees desired him that he would eat with him. And he went into the Pharisee's house, and sat down to meat.

<sup>37</sup> And, behold, a woman in the city, which was a sinner, when she knew that Jesus sat at meat in the Pharisee's house, brought an alabaster box of ointment,

<sup>38</sup> And stood at his feet behind him weeping, and began to wash

his feet with tears, and did wipe them with the hairs of her head, and kissed his feet, and anointed them with the ointment.

**39** Now when the Pharisee which had bidden him saw it, he spake within himself, saying, This man, if he were a prophet, would have known who and what manner of woman this is that toucheth him: for she is a sinner.

**40** And Jesus answering said unto him, Simon, I have somewhat to say unto thee. And he saith, Master, say on.

**41** There was a certain creditor which had two debtors: the one owed five hundred pence, and the other fifty.

**42** And when they had nothing to pay, he frankly forgave them both. Tell me therefore, which of them will love him most?

**43** Simon answered and said, I suppose that he, to whom he forgave most. And he said unto him, Thou hast rightly judged.

**44** And he turned to the woman, and said unto Simon, Seest thou this woman? I entered into thine house, thou gavest me no water for my feet: but she hath washed my feet with tears, and wiped them with the hairs of her head.

**45** Thou gavest me no kiss: but this woman since the time I came in hath not ceased to kiss my feet.

**46** My head with oil thou didst not anoint: but this woman hath anointed my feet with ointment.

**47** Wherefore I say unto thee, Her sins, which are many, are forgiven; for she loved much: but to whom little is forgiven, the same loveth little.

**48** And he said unto her, Thy sins are forgiven.

**49** And they that sat at meat with him began to say within themselves, Who is this that forgiveth sins also?

<sup>50</sup> And he said to the woman, Thy faith hath saved thee; go in peace.

The self-righteous pride of the Pharisee blinded him from acknowledging his own sins which is a requirement for forgiveness and mercy. This shows that you can be a top religious leader and lack basic understanding. He compared himself to the Publican as if he was perfect but God is going to accept that publican because he was humble and contrite and feared God. The publican represents all the harlots and common criminals that repent and believe in God for salvation. They will be justified whilst the so called Christians and pastors will not!

Luke 18:9-14

King James Version (KJV)

<sup>9</sup> And he spake this parable unto certain which trusted in themselves that they were righteous, and despised others:

<sup>10</sup> Two men went up into the temple to pray; the one a Pharisee, and the other a publican.

<sup>11</sup> The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, God, I thank thee, that I am not as other men are, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican.

<sup>12</sup> I fast twice in the week, I give tithes of all that I possess.

<sup>13</sup> And the publican, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as his eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, God be merciful to me a sinner.

<sup>14</sup> I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other: for every one that exalteth himself shall be

**abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.**

**The story of the Samaritan woman at the well shows how you can think you know Jesus or the Truth but if you haven't learned from True Israelites then you don't. You will then be faced with the decision to follow it or not. She was wise to follow and believe as she was exposed and humbled herself. God is merciful if we humble ourselves.**

**John 4:9**

**King James Version (KJV)**

<sup>9</sup> Then saith the woman of Samaria unto him, How is it that thou, being a Jew, askest drink of me, which am a woman of Samaria? for the Jews have no dealings with the Samaritans.

<sup>10</sup> Jesus answered and said unto her, If thou knewest the gift of God, and who it is that saith to thee, Give me to drink; thou wouldest have asked of him, and he would have given thee living water.

<sup>15</sup> The woman saith unto him, Sir, give me this water, that I thirst not, neither come hither to draw.

<sup>16</sup> Jesus saith unto her, Go, call thy husband, and come hither.

<sup>17</sup> The woman answered and said, I have no husband. Jesus said unto her, Thou hast well said, I have no husband:

<sup>18</sup> For thou hast had five husbands; and he whom thou now hast is not thy husband: in that saidst thou truly.

<sup>19</sup> The woman saith unto him, Sir, I perceive that thou art a



prophet.

<sup>20</sup> Our fathers worshipped in this mountain; and ye say, that in Jerusalem is the place where men ought to worship.

<sup>21</sup> Jesus saith unto her, Woman, believe me, the hour cometh, when ye shall neither in this mountain, nor yet at Jerusalem, worship the Father.

<sup>22</sup> Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews.

**God does not love everyone and does not tolerate hypocrites and false worship. He hates all wickedness and mainstream Christianity is full of hypocrisy which is why he rejects their praises and sacrifices. Hence, they are serving "God" in vain.**

**Amos 5:21-24**

**King James Version (KJV)**

<sup>21</sup> I hate, I despise your feast days, and I will not smell in your solemn assemblies.

<sup>22</sup> Though ye offer me burnt offerings and your meat offerings, I will not accept them: neither will I regard the peace offerings of your fat beasts.

<sup>23</sup> Take thou away from me the noise of thy songs; for I will not hear the melody of thy viols.

<sup>24</sup> But let judgment run down as waters, and righteousness as a mighty stream.

**Most fake Christians and family members will hear the truth of what we tell them, and even agree but will not follow it due to their own covetousness!**

**Ezekiel 33:30-32**

<sup>30</sup> Also, thou son of man, the children of thy people still are talking against thee by the walls and in the doors of the houses, and speak one to another, every one to his brother, saying, Come, I pray you, and hear what is the word that cometh forth from the Lord.

<sup>31</sup> And they come unto thee as the people cometh, and they sit before thee as my people, and they hear thy words, but they will not do them: for with their mouth they shew much love, but their heart goeth after their covetousness.

<sup>32</sup> And, lo, thou art unto them as a very lovely song of one that hath a pleasant voice, and can play well on an instrument: for they hear thy words, but they do them not.

**These fake Christians have been prophesied of. They are in every generations but they are hypocrites that worship God in vain!**

**Matthew 15:7-9**

<sup>7</sup> Ye hypocrites, well did Esaias prophesy of you, saying,

<sup>8</sup>This people draweth nigh unto me with their mouth, and honoureth me with their lips; but their heart is far from me.

<sup>9</sup>But in vain they do worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men.

Fake Christians think that they are saved despite the fact that they are living in sin. The difference is that when common sinners find out about Christ, they keep it real enough to acknowledge their wrong doings and actually repent instead of trying to hold on to an idol that they believe gives them the liberty to sin and still be on good terms with God. Fake Christians will be in for a rude awakening.

1 Corinthians 6:9-11

King James Version (KJV)

<sup>9</sup>Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind,

<sup>10</sup>Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God.

<sup>11</sup>And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.

Most so called Christians feel as if they know Jesus but they really do not because they do not obey Him. God is willing to

accept and forgive anyone but they must follow Him and not their own hearts if they want eternal life.

1 John 2:1-4

2 My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:

<sup>2</sup> And he is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world.

<sup>3</sup> And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments.

<sup>4</sup> He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.
